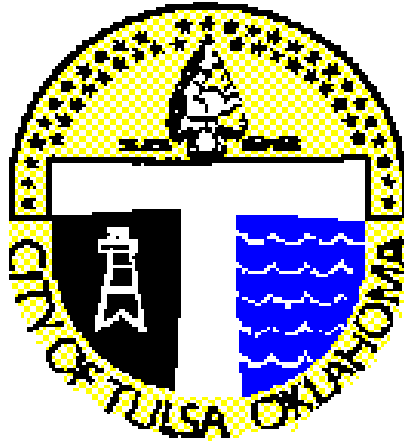

### NO EXCEPTIONS TO THESE TERMS & CONDITIONS WILL BE CONSIDERED.

1. **BIDS MUST BE SUBMITTED ON THIS FORM ONLY INCLUDING A SIGNATURE OF AN AUTHORIZED AGENT.** Each bid shall be placed in a separate envelope. Be sure envelope is completely and properly identified and sealed, showing the bid number and date in the lower left hand corner. Bids must be time stamped in the office of the City Clerk by 5:00 P.M. on the day before date of opening.
2. No bidder may withdraw his proposal for a period of thirty (30) days after the date and hour set for the opening of bids.
3. All prices shall be quoted F.O.B. Tulsa, Oklahoma, and delivery to City of Tulsa location shall be without additional charge.
4. The bidder shall attach the manufacturer's name of the equipment or material to be furnished, type, model numbers, manufacturer's descriptive bulletins and specifications. All guarantees and warranties should be clearly stated. This data shall be in sufficient detail to describe accurately the equipment or material to be furnished. Manufacturer's specifications, in respect to the successful bidder, shall be considered as part of his contract with the City of Tulsa.
5. The bidder shall show in the proposal both the unit prices and total amount, where required, of each item listed. In the event of error or discrepancy in the mathematics, the unit prices shall prevail.
6. Any exceptions or deviations from written specifications shall be shown in writing and attached to the bid form.
7. Each bidder agrees to comply with the terms of Title 5, Chapter 1, of Tulsa, Oklahoma Charter and revised ordinances relating to equal employment opportunity.
8. **THE ENCLOSED FORMS REGARDING NON-COLLUSION AND FINANCIAL INTEREST MUST BE SIGNED, NOTARIZED, AND RETURNED WITH THE BID.**
9. The City of Tulsa reserves the right to reject any and all bids, to waive any technicalities in the bidding, and to award each item to different bidders or all items to a single bidder.
10. All bids must be accompanied by bidders bond, cash, certified or cashier's check in the amount shown on the face of the bid form. This amount shall be retained by the City of Tulsa as liquidated damages in the event the successful bidder (or bidders) fails to execute a contract, if required. The bidder agrees that said amount is presumed to be the damages sustained by the City due to the impracticability and extreme difficulty in fixing the actual damages. The office of the City Clerk will return the bid deposits to the unsuccessful bidders, after a contract has been awarded or all bids have been rejected.
11. In the event cash discounts are offered by the bidder, the discount date shall begin with the date of invoice, the date of receipt of all material covered by the purchase order, or the date of receipt by the City of Tulsa of the original copy of the purchase order with properly executed Affidavit of Claimant, whichever is the later date.
12. Direct purchase of certain items of equipment or material by the City of Tulsa are exempt from Federal Excise Tax and Oklahoma Sales Tax. In such cases the bidder shall quote prices which do not include Federal Excise Tax and Oklahoma Sales Tax. The City of Tulsa will furnish executed exemption certificates upon presentation by the bidder at the time of purchase.
13. Bid must show number of days required for delivery under normal conditions. Failure to state delivery time obligates bidder to complete delivery in fourteen (14) calendar days. Unrealistically short or long delivery promises may cause bid to be disregarded. Contractor must keep Purchasing Department advised at all times of status of order. Default in promised delivery or failure to meet specifications authorizes the Purchasing Agent to purchase supplies elsewhere and charge full increase of cost and handling to defaulting contractor. Consistent failure to meet delivery promises without valid reason may cause removal from bid list.
14. Bidder agrees to defend and save City of Tulsa from and against all demands, claims, suits, costs, expenses, damages and judgments based upon infringement of any patent relating to goods specified in this order or the ordinary use or operation of such goods by City or use or operation of such goods in accordance with bidders direction.

PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT**

1. **SCOPE OF WORK** – The work to be performed under this contract is the scheduled cleaning/sweeping of selected public arterial and residential streets within the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma. This work shall include all labor, equipment, materials and any other incidental items necessary to complete the work in the specific manner.
  - 1.1 The cleaning of public streets is defined as the removal of dirt, encrusted, caked or otherwise, and the removal of all debris and foreign matter, including gutter grass from within a five (5) foot strip adjacent to and parallel to the curbs and medians along the public street being cleaned. Gutter grass is defined as grass growing parallel to the curb where the vertical face of the curb meets the horizontal surface of the street. This includes the removal of all debris from the surface of any storm sewer inlet which may lie within this pathway. If parked cars or other obstructions are present along the curb line, the contractor shall clean around the cars or obstructions as closely as possible and continue along the curb line. The entire radius of all residential streets intersecting with arterial streets shall be swept as part of the arterial street.
  - 1.2 The methods utilized in performing this work may include the use of mechanical street sweepers, vacuum sweeper or hand brooms and shovels, whichever is appropriate for the existing conditions. **Bidders are advised that manual labor is often required to remove foreign objects and caked debris from the path of sweepers, especially at dead ends, which must be completely cleaned under the terms of this contract.**
2. **LOCATION OF WORK** – The street cleaning service to be provided under this contract will be on designated City of Tulsa arterial and residential streets as identified in Appendices No. 1 and No. 2 respectively of this specifications. The City will reserve the right to add or delete streets and/or change the limits of the streets which will be swept under this contract. There is no guarantee that any or all arterial or residential streets will be cleaned under this contract.
3. **SWEEPING SCHEDULE** – The schedule for this cleaning service will be at the direction of the Department of Public Works, Public Facilities Maintenance Division. It is planned the designated 573.7 arterial street miles and 2,285 residential street miles will be swept eight (8) and four (4) times a year (4,589.6 miles and 9,140 curb miles) respectively. Sweeping operations may be curtailed during inclement weather.

4. **CURB MILES** – The basis for the price of this cleaning service will be the number of curb miles cleaned. The curb mile will be measured linearly from the starting point 5,280 feet to the terminal point along a single curb line including all intersecting streets. The curb miles for the designated streets appearing in Appendices No. 1 and No. 2 of these specifications have been verified by City of Tulsa technicians and will be used for the basis for payment of this contract. Changes to the approved curb mileage will be made in writing by the Contract Manager.
  
5. **DISPOSAL OF DEBRIS** – The contractor shall be responsible for the disposal of all collected dirt, debris and other matter in an approved manner, at a licensed sanitary landfill and pay all fees as required by Federal, State, County and City of Tulsa laws, statutes, regulations and ordinances. Prior to commencement of work the contractor shall submit in writing to the City for approval thereof the site at which the contractor intends to dispose of such dirt, debris and/or waste material collected. The contractor shall provide the City with a monthly report detailing debris disposal amounts.
  - 5.1 **WATER** – The contractor will be required to secure and use a construction meter from the Water Distribution Section for all water used. Failure to use a meter is a violation of City Ordinances. There will be no charge for water. ***Sweepers must use water at all times***, except when temperatures are below freezing. Excessive dust created by sweeping operations will result in the shut down of sweeping until proper dust control is achieved.
  
6. **QUALITY OF WORK** – The contractor’s work shall always be of an acceptable level. The contractor is expected to maintain a quality control program and to inspect all work prior to presenting the work to the City for inspection.
  - 6.1 The general guidelines for the specified quality street sweeping shall include, but are not limited to the following:
    - (a.) The street must show evidence of being swept and present an appearance of cleanliness and all “gutter grass” must be removed. The contractor will have one year (four cycles) to remove all gutter grass from residential streets.
    - (b.) There will be no significant sweeping trailing or scattering of dirt, debris or other matter following the sweeper.
    - (c.) Any dirt, debris or other matter remaining on the street shall be less than three (3) cubic feet per continuous curb mile.
    - (d.) The sweeper operator must at all times observe proper sweeping procedures.
    - (e.) The street must be cleaner behind the sweeper than in front.

6.2 The City of Tulsa, Public Facilities Maintenance division will inspect all work performed. The inspection will be performed within three (3), or less work days after notification from the contractor that the work has been completed and the contractor will be notified of any deficiencies noted. Progressive inspections will be performed on entire streets only and not on segments thereof, except in mutually agreed upon entenuating circumstances. The contractor will be required to re-sweep at no additional cost any street which does not meet specifications.

6.2.1 The contractor shall have forty-eight (48) hours to correct any deficiencies noted during the first inspection. Failure to meet an acceptable standard of cleanliness on the second inspection will result in payment being withheld for that particular street.

6.2.2 The Inspector shall have the authority to delete streets or segments of streets from the cleaning authorization which cannot be cleaned because of obstructions, construction, natural disasters or other mitigating circumstances and adjust the curb miles accordingly.

6.2.3 Sand spread by City forces during winter storm control operations will be removed by the Contractor as part of the normal course of this contract. Time extensions **MAY** be granted to the contractor because of sanding operations, but no additional compensation will be made.

7. **REPORTS** – The Contractor will be provided with a schedule of when and which streets will be swept. This schedule may be published in the local media. Also, the contractor will be required to furnissh a report with each invoice after the work has been completed, detailing the amount of dirt and debris picked up on each street and/or zone and the amount of water used, **including meter readings.**

8. **PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND SAFETY** – The contractor shall observe City ordinances relating to obstructing streets, keeping alleys or other rights-of-way open and protecting same, and shall obey all laws and City ordinances controlling or limiting those engaged in the work required under this contract. The contractor is granted the right of using the streets or alleys for the purpose of doing the work specified in the contract, but is not granted the exclusive use of such streets or alleys. The contractor shall perform the work in a manner that will cause the least inconvenience and annoyance to the general public and property owners.

The contractor shall be restricted from performing any work on the named **ARTERIAL** streets from between 6:30 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. or between 3:30 p.m. and 6:30 p.m. Monday through Friday. The contractor shall be restricted from performing any work on residential streets on weekends, City of Tulsa holidays and between 5:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m. Monday through Friday.

9. **TERM OF CONTRACT** – The term of this contract shall be for a one (1) year period beginning on the official execution date of this contract. It shall be possible to renew this contract for four (4) additional one (1) year periods beyond the initial term upon mutual agreement of both parties. Any proposed change in the current unit price per curb mile shall be limited to a factor equal to the change in the Consumer Price Index for all cities, as published by the U.S. Department of Labor Statistics for the prior twelve (12) month period. The agreement between both parties to exercise this extension option must be completed at least sixty (60) days prior to the expiration of the then current contract.
10. **INTERPRETATION OF SPECIFICATIONS** - If any bidder is in doubt as to the true meaning of any part of these specifications, the bidder may request an interpretation from the Contract Manager. Any interpretation will be made only by an addendum duly mailed or delivered to all prospective bidders who filed for a copy of the bid specifications with the City of Tulsa Purchasing Department. In order to have a request for interpretation considered, the request must be received by the Contract Manager not less than seven (7) working days prior to the bid opening date. All bidders must sign any addendum issued and attach it to their proposal in order to have their bid considered.
11. **EXAMINATION OF WORK SITE** – **By the submission of a proposal, the bidder represents that he/she has examined the named streets to be swept, the specifications, and all other bid documents. The bidder further represents that he/she is fully informed concerning the requirements of the specifications, and the physical conditions to be encountered in the work, and the character, quality and the quantity of the service to be performed. The successful bidder will not be entitled to additional compensation if he/she subsequently finds that conditions require methods or equipment other than that anticipated when preparing his/her bid.**
12. **PERFORMANCE BOND** – The contractor shall obtain a performance bond in the amount of **100%** of the contract value for one year guaranteeing faithful performance of the contract over the contract period. In lieu of this performance bond, the contractor may enter into an agreement with the City, dependent upon the approval of the City's'Legal staff, to make a deposit in cash in the amount equal to the amount of the performance bond.
13. **EQUAL EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY** – The contractor's attention is directed to all Federal and State laws and City of Tulsa ordinances relating to equal employment opportunity.
14. **LAWS TO BE OBSERVED** - The contractor at all times shall observe and comply with all applicable Federal and State laws, local laws, ordinances, orders and regulations of the Federal, State County or City governments. The submission of a bid on this work shall be considered as a representation that the bidder is familiar with all Federal, State and local laws, ordinances and

regulations which affect those engaged or employed in the work, or equipment used in the work, or which in any way affects the conduct of the work, and no pleas of misunderstanding will be considered on account of ignorance thereof.

15. **TAXES** – The contractor shall pay all Federal, State and Local taxes which may be chargeable against the performance of this work and the consideration paid thereof.

16. **The contractor shall secure and maintain throughout the duration of this contract policies of insurance and furnish to the City Certificates of insurance of such types an dnot less than the amounts as hereinafter listed:**

(a) **Vehicle Liability** – The contractor shall carry, in his/her own name, a policy of the comprehensive form to insure the entire vehicle liability for this operation with limits no less than:

The contractor, and any subcontractors, shall carry and keep in force during this contract policies of public liability insurance including any contractual liability assumed under this contract in the minimum amounts set forth below and workmen’s compensation and employer’s liability insurance in the amounts required by law. The contractor shall also furnish an owner’s protective policy in the same amounts with the City of Tulsa as the named assured by the same insurance company as the insurer of contractor’s liability coverage, and the issuing company **must** be licensed to do business in the State of Oklahoma.

<b>Property Damage, each person</b>	<b>\$ 25,000</b>
<b>Property Damage; each occurrence</b>	<b>\$1,000,000</b>

**The policy shall provide a clause stating that it cannot be canceled by the insurer without the insurer first giving the City ten- (10) days written notice of cancellation. The successful bidder shall furnish**

**the City a certificate of insurance showing such coverage within ten-(10) days following the acceptance of the bid by the City.**

**(b) Workmen's Compensation and Employer's Liability (as required By law).**

Regardless of these requirements and of such approval by the City, it will be the responsibility of the contractor to maintain adequate insurance coverage at all times, and failure to do so will not relieve any contractual obligations or responsibilities. Failure on the part of the contractor, however, to maintain these policies in full effect for the duration of the contract will be considered as a failure in contract performance and will be treated as such by the City.

**CONTRACTOR'S LIABILITY AND INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS:**

**General Liability:** The City of Tulsa shall not be liable for any loss or damage sustained by the contractor. The contractor shall save the City of Tulsa whole and harmless from any and all claims of whatsoever nature growing out of or resulting from or in any way connected with the exercise of the privilege herein granted. Contractor will exercise every necessary precaution for the safety of the property and the protection of any and all persons and/or property located adjacent to or making passage through said property.

**Liens:** The contractor agrees to indemnify and hold the City harmless from all claims, demands, causes of action or suits of whatever nature arising out of the services, labor and materials furnished by the Contractor or his subcontractors under the scope of this bid and from all laborer's materialmen's and mechanics' liens upon the real property upon which the work is located or any property of the City of Tulsa.

**Premiums:** Premiums on all insurance policies shall be paid by the Contractor and shall be deemed included in his service agreement unless otherwise specified.

Performance bonds and/or evidence of insurance required of the successful bidder on this bid solicitation must be delivered to:

**17. PERMITS -** Before the Notice to proceed will be issued, the contractor shall obtain and pay for all necessary permits and licenses whether issued by the State, County or City and furnish proof thereof.

18. **CITY NOT LIABLE FOR DELAY** – It is further expressly agreed that in no event shall the City be liable or responsible to the contractor or any other person for or on account of any stoppage or delay in the work herein provided for by injunction or other legal or equitable proceedings, or from or by or on account of any delay for any cause over which the City has no control.
19. **PRE-BID CONFERENCES-** Mandatory pre-bid conferences will be held on January 17, 2001 at 10:00 a.m. and January 18, 2001 at 10:00 a.m. in Room 633 at City Hall to answer any questions concerning this bid. Bidders **MUST** attend one conference.
20. **PREPARATION OF BID** – The prospective bidders shall use the forms attached to this specification. The forms shall be typed, and shall be executed by the bidder in ink with bidder's full and complete legal name and signature. The bidder shall indicate whether an individual, partnership, joint venture, Oklahoma corporation or a foreign corporation, and shall enter the correct legal name of the bidder as well as the individual and the title of the individual signing for and on behalf of the bidder. The business address and telephone number shall be entered on the form. The bid shall be signed by the owner, authorized agent or authorized corporate officer.
- Any omission of prices on the bid forms, or any additions in writing on the bid forms, or any other inserted or otherwise stated conditions, limitations or provisions, will render the proposal informal and may be cause for its rejection. The bidder shall state the per curb price for each class of cleaning as shown on the bid sheet and based on the schedule given as a minimum amount of cleaning for the year.
21. **DELIVERY OF BID** – All bids shall be delivered in a sealed envelope to the Office of the City Clerk, 200 Civic Center, Room 109, on or before the date set forth in the Notice to Bidders. It is the responsibility of the bidder to see that the bid and bidders bond is delivered on time. Any bid received after the scheduled closing time will be returned unopened to the bidder.
22. **BIDDER'S BOND-** A bid will not be considered unless accompanied by a certified check, a cashier's check, or a bid bond in the amount of **\$5,000.00**. The check or bond shall be made payable to the City of Tulsa. The bid bond shall be a guarantee that the bidder, if awarded the contract, will furnish the performance bond, certificates of insurance and other required data, and execute the contract. If the bidder fails to supply these documents and execute the contract, the bid bond will be forfeited to the City as liquidated damages for the bidder's breach.
23. **RELEASE OF BIDDER'S BOND** – After all bids have been opened and properly evaluated and the bid awarded to the successful bidder, the bid bonds of rejected or unsuccessful bidders will be returned in five (5) days. The Bid Bond for the successful bidder will be returned upon entering into a contract with the City for this service.

- 24. WITHDRAWAL OR REVISION OF PROPOSAL** – The bidder may without prejudice, withdraw, modify or correct his/her bid which has been deposited with the City Auditor prior to the closing date providing such request is made in writing. All modifications or corrections made by telegram or other written communication received on time will be opened and read aloud prior to the opening of bids. When such modifications and corrections are in order and acceptable, the changes will be made a part of the respective bid package
- 25. OPENING OF BIDS** – All bids will be opened and read aloud at the time and place set forth in the Notice to Bidders.
- 26. ACCEPTANCE OR REJECTION OF BIDS** – The City reserves the right to accept the lowest and best bid or to reject any and all bids and to waive minor irregularities in the bid.
- 27. AWARD OF BID** – The award of a bid, if made, will be made within thirty (30) days following the bid opening to the responsible bidder who submits the lowest and best bid for Item 1 and Item 2 combined. Alternate bid items, will not be split between contractors. No award will be made until all necessary investigations have been made to determine the qualifications of the bidder under consideration.
- 28. QUALIFICATION OF BIDDER** – The successful bidder must be a contractor involved in this type or similar work and/or demonstrate his/her capabilities to perform the work required by this contract.
- 28.1 To demonstrate these qualifications, the successful bidder will be required to provide the City the following:
- (a) History of past work experience with type of work, names, addresses, and telephone numbers.
  - (b) A current financial statement
  - (c) A list of employees with past experience
  - (d) A list of equipment available, condition, outstanding liens and plans to acquire additional equipment.
  - (e) A plan for the disposal of debris, including disposal sites.
  - (f) A firm statement of when he/she will be able to begin work after award of contract.
- 29. PREPARATION OF CONTRACT-** The City of Tulsa legal staff will prepare the contract and deliver copies to the successful bidder.

30. **EXECUTION OF CONTRACT** – The successful bidder will within ten (10) working days after receipt of the contract, execute all copies and return all copies along with the performance bond, certificates of insurance and any other required forms to the City of Tulsa legal staff.
31. **AWARD OF CONTRACT** - The City of Tulsa's legal staff will, after assuring that the contract has been properly executed and all other legal requirements have been met, present the contract to the Mayor for final approval and execution. Copies of the fully executed contract will be provided to the bidder.
32. **VERBAL AGREEMENTS** – No verbal agreements or conversation with any officer, agent, or employee of the City, either before or after execution of the contract shall affect or modify any of the terms or obligations contained within the written contract. Any verbal agreement or conversation shall be considered as unofficial information and is in no way binding on the City or on the bidder.
33. **ISSUANCE OF WORK ORDERS** – A Work Order will be issued by the Contract Manager instructing the contractor to proceed for a one year period.
34. **PAYMENT** – The contractor shall submit an invoice and applicable affidavit, along with a report for the work performed. Upon satisfactory inspection, the City will then process payment to the contractor.
35. **CHARACTER OF WORKMEN AND WORK** – The contractor and his/her employees, including subcontractors, shall be competent and careful workmen skilled in their respective trades. The contractor shall not employ any person who is incompetent or negligent in the due and proper performance of his/her duties. The City shall retain the right to require the contractor to remove any employee from contact with the public who is determined by the City, after due investigation of any complaint of having been guilty of misconduct to the public. This work is being performed for the public benefit and it is necessary that it be performed in an acceptable manner and at a satisfactory rate of progress.
36. **EQUIPMENT**- The contractor shall at all times maintain his/her equipment in a clean, serviceable condition. All equipment shall be properly licensed and inspected and clearly marked with the contractor's name. The continued use of unserviceable and improper equipment shall be considered a breach of contract. The City may make random equipment inspections to insure that equipment is functioning properly. Deficiencies shall require immediate repair and/or adjustment.
37. **ASSIGNING OF SUBLETTING THE CONTRACT**- The contractor shall not assign or sublet the contract or any portion of the contract without written approval of the City. The City's written approval of the contractor subletting work shall not be considered as making the City a party of such subcontract or subjecting the City to liability of any kind to any subcontractor. Under no circumstances shall subcontracting of any work relieve the contractor or the contractor's surety of the contractor's liabilities and obligations under the

contract. All transactions will be made through the contractor. Subcontractors will be recognized and dealt with only as workmen of the contractor.

**38. BREACH OF CONTRACT** – All terms, conditions and specifications of the contract shall be considered material and failure to perform any part of the contract shall be considered a breach of contract. Furthermore, if the contractor fails to provide the cleaning service required by this contract for a period in excess of five (5) consecutive scheduled working days, the City may declare the contractor to be in breach of contract.

**39. MODIFICATION** - This contract constitutes the entire agreement and understanding between the parties hereto, and it shall not be considered modified, altered, changed or amended in any respect unless in writing and signed by both parties.

**BID PRICES:**

Bid prices are to be firm for the duration of the contract.

**CONTRACT CANCELLATION:**

Irrespective of any breach of the provisions set forth herein, City shall have the right to cancel the contract upon thirty (30) days written notice to the Contractor. Contractor shall have the right to cancel the contract upon ninety (90) days written notice to the City.

**ASSIGNMENT:**

The successful bidder shall not sell, sublet, or assign this agreement or any portion thereof to any person or persons, except upon the written approval of the city of Tulsa.

The contractor shall comply with all applicable governmental laws and regulations.

**SCOPE:**

It is the intent during the contract period, as nearly as possible, to purchase all the requirements for the items bid from the firm(s) to which the contract is awarded. This does not include materials supplied under terms of a public improvement contract let for a specific project by the City.

Copies of all licenses should be placed on file and returned with contract.

**EMPLOYMENT DISCRIMINATION BY CONTRACTOR PROHIBITED:**

**A. During the performance of this contract, the contractor agrees as follows.**

1. The contractor will not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment because of race, religion, color, sex or national origin, except where religion, sex or national origin is a bona fide occupational qualification reasonable necessary to the normal operation of the

contractor. The contractor agrees to post in conspicuous places, available to employees and applicants for employment, notices setting forth the provision of this non—discrimination clause.

2. The contractor, in all solicitations or advertisements for employment placed by or on behalf of the contractor, will state that such contractor is an equal opportunity employer.
  3. Notices, advertisements and solicitations placed in accordance with federal law, rule or regulation shall be deemed sufficient for the purpose of meeting the requirements of this section.
- B. The contractor will include the provision of the foregoing paragraphs of this section in every subcontract or purchase order of over \$10,000 so that the provisions will be binding upon each subcontractor or vendor.

### **ALTERING BIDS:**

Bids cannot be altered or amended after submission deadline. Any interlineation, alteration, or erasure made before opening time and date must be initialed by the signer of the bid, guaranteeing authenticity. Bids must be submitted in ink or typewritten. Penciling will not be accepted.

### **PRICE ADJUSTMENT OPTION:**

The price paid for a commodity under this contract shall not change during the term of this contract. However, if the bidder anticipates that it will not be able to maintain firm prices for any renewal periods, a change in price may be allowed in a renewal of this contract if the following criteria are met:

- 1) The bidder includes a formula, to be used to calculate a change in price at the time of renewal, in the bid for the initial contract. Such formula shall be reasonable, objective and capable of measurement.
- 2) The contractor notifies the city, in writing, no later than 60 days prior to the expiration of the initial contract period, or any renewal period, of its intent to exercise the right to escalate or de-escalate prices under the contract. The notice shall include a calculation of the price increase or decrease requested including the formula used.

### **BIDDER AFFIDAVITS:**

Each bidder shall accompany his bid with a fully executed and notarized copy of the attached Non-Collusion Affidavit and the Interest Affidavit. Failure to do so shall be cause for rejection of the bid.

## **ADDENDA AND INTERPRETATIONS:**

If it becomes necessary to revise any part of this bid, a written addendum will be provided to all the bidders. The City of Tulsa is not bound by any oral representations, clarifications, or changes made in the written specifications by City of Tulsa employees unless such clarification or change is provided to bidders in written addendum form from the Purchasing Division.

## **AWARD OF BID:**

The bid shall be awarded to the firm whose proposal is responsive to the bid and is most advantageous to the City, considering the factors identified in the bid and Section 406E of Title 6, The Purchasing Ordinance set forth below:

### 406E. AWARD OF CONTRACT

1. Authority in the Mayor. The Mayor shall have the authority to award contracts within the purview of this chapter.
2. Lowest Secure Bidder. Contracts shall be awarded to the lowest secure bidder meeting specifications. Bid Specifications may include a point system for evaluating the lowest secure bid. In determining "lowest secure bidder", in addition to price, the following factors shall be considered:
  - a. The ability, capacity and skill of the bidder to perform the contract or provide the service required;
  - b. whether the bidder can perform the contract or provide the service promptly or within the time specified, without delay or interference;
  - c. the character, integrity, reputation, judgment, experience and efficiency of the bidder;
  - d. the quality of performance of previous contracts or services;
  - e. the previous and existing compliance by the bidder with laws and ordinances relating to the contract or service;
  - f. the sufficiency of the financial resources and ability of the bidder to perform the contract or provide the service;
  - g. the quality, availability and adaptability of the supplies or contractual services to the particular use required;
  - h. the ability of the bidder to provide future maintenance and service for the use of the subject of the contract;
  - i. where an earlier delivery date would be of great benefit to the requisitioning agency, the date and terms of delivery may be considered in the bid award, and

- j. the number and scope of conditions attached to the bid.
- k. if a point system has been utilized in the bid specifications, the number of points earned by the bidder.
